“Face to face” conversation

This type of language exchange is known as conversation exchange. You practice your second language by **meeting up** with native speakers living nearby.

What is a Conversation Exchange?

Well, the best way to explain it is through an example. Michael is from Liverpool and has recently moved to Macisvenda. His Spanish is a bit patchy and he would like to improve it. Catalina is from Abanilla and she is learning English, but she never has the opportunity to listen and speak to native English speakers. Now, Michael and Catalina could help each other out. For example they can meet up once a week and have a conversation exchange, and speak half an hour in English and half an hour in Spanish. There is no cost or homework involved and you learn the language in a social environment. Furthermore, you are more likely to learn slang and other things about a culture that you do not usually learn in a formal language class.
